Compliance with California Public Resources Code Sections 47115-47116

California law requires a pharmaceutical manufacturer that sells or distributes a medication in California usually intended to be self-injected at home to annually file a plan with CalRecycle describing how the manufacturer supports the safe collection and proper disposal of waste devices.

Grifols' prescribing information for products intended to be self-injected at home includes language that advises the patient to dispose of any used administration equipment in an appropriate container. Grifols products that are intended for use in the home are dispensed by licensed specialty pharmacies, homecare companies or hospital providers. Each of these entities has their own procedures for the safe collection and disposal of waste devices, and perform these services in connection with the dispensing of Grifols' products.

Moreover, Grifols is a member of the Pharmaceutical Product Stewardship Work Group (PPSWG), an association for drug and sharp manufacturers and marketers. The group was formed to address the complexities and uncertainties of laws governing the disposal of unused and unwanted pharmaceutical products. PPSWG provides members with a platform to organize and present science-based data about safe pharmaceutical disposal practices. PPSWG also organizes the industry's efforts to raise awareness about appropriate disposal methods, and to respond to disposal laws.
