WATER POLICY

Grifols is a leading global company in the healthcare sector. Our innovative plasma-derived medicines, other biopharmaceuticals and transfusion medicine solutions help improve the quality of life for millions of patients around the world. We are aware that water is a relevant natural resource for our operations and for society. Our commitment to sustainability and public health includes responsible water management in all our facilities, mainly in the production facilities, located in different geographical environments, some of them subject to water stress. This policy is part of the company's Environmental Policy and is aligned with the rest of the policies related to the Environment and Sustainability, as well as with applicable legislation, international standards and reference frameworks.

These principles apply to all centers and people who work in and for Grifols.

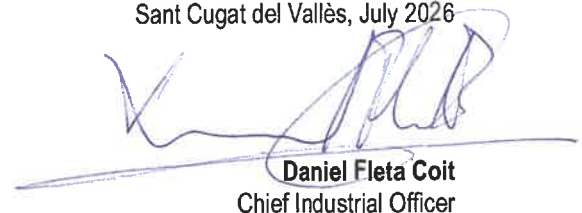
Grifols is committed to:

- Comply with all water and discharge legislation in all countries in which we operate, including local permits, regulatory limits and pharmaceutical quality standards and go above and beyond where technically and economically feasible.
- Maintain systems to verify compliance with these limits and promote continuous improvement.
- Evaluate and set objectives for improving and optimizing the efficiency of water consumption, both well and network, in those locations with the highest demand and with a greater emphasis on those located in areas of water stress.
- Evaluate and optimize manufacturing, cleaning, and cooling processes to decrease water use per unit of production whenever possible.
- Prioritize technologies with low water consumption, internal reuse and recirculation when technically feasible and which, in no case, can compromise the quality and safety of the product.
- Have adequate wastewater treatment systems in production plants that require it to guarantee the reduction and/or elimination of polluting parameters, including active pharmaceutical ingredients (APIs), PFAs or other emerging contaminants if necessary.
- Promote investments for innovation in wastewater treatment.
- Include targets for reducing water extraction, consumption, and pollution in the company's Environmental Programs. These objectives and their evolution will be made public through the company's Environmental Programs and/or reports.
- Report our water performance following international standards.
- Periodically assess water risk and its financial impact.
- Collaborate with local communities, authorities and other stakeholders to support the improvement of water availability and quality at the local level.
- Participate in initiatives with other pharmaceutical companies, public administrations and international organisations to promote sustainable water management along the entire value chain.

Through this policy, we reinforce our commitment to the protection of water resources, the reduction of our environmental impact on this vector and compliance with international standards, contributing to a more sustainable future for the communities in which we operate and for future generations.

This document and its compliance are periodically reviewed by the Grifols Environment Committee following internal procedures.
